**Purpose and legal basis of the Register**

The purpose of the register is to communicate the services of Prizztech Ltd to customers and stakeholders. The processing of personal data is based on Prizztech Ltd's legitimate interest in providing information on our services.

**Regular sources of information in the Register**

The information provided by the recipient of the newsletter or the Priztech Ltd customer register.

## **Ordinary transfer of personal data and transfer of data outside the EU or EEA**

No release or transfer of data outside the EU or EEA.

## **Data retention time**

Personal data will only be retained for as long as it is necessary for the purposes specified in this document.

Personal data will be retained for customer relationship. Personal data may also be retained, if necessary, after the termination of the customer relationship, to the extent permitted or required by applicable law. For example, after the end of our relationship, we typically keep personal information that is necessary to meet demands or claims in accordance with the current limitation period. For example, we may retain personal information as necessary to comply with your direct marketing ban.

Personal data will be deleted when their retention is no longer necessary to carry out the law, or either party's rights or obligations.

## **Principles of registry protection**

Manual material

Data is not stored manually.

Electronic material

The information is kept technically protected. Physical access to data is blocked by access control as well as other security measures. Access to data requires adequate rights, as well as multi-stage recognition. Unauthorized access is also prevented by, for example, firewalls and technical protection. Only registered inspectors and technically specially appointed persons can access the register information. Only designated persons have the right to process and maintain the registry information. Users are bound by the confidentiality obligation. The registration information is backed up safely and will be returned as needed. The level of security is audited at recurring intervals either by external or internal auditing.

## **Registered right of inspection**

A person in the register has the right to inspect and, if necessary, to correct what information about him is in the register. The request must be made in writing to the registry administrator. A person in the register has the right to make changes to the information that has been incorrectly entered in the register.

## **Right to demand correction**

A person in the register has the right to request the registrar to access personal data concerning himself and to request rectification or removal of such information or limitation of the processing or to object to the processing and the right to transfer data from one system to another.

## **Other rights related to the processing of personal data**

A person in the register has the right to the extent that the processing of personal data is based on the consent of the data subject, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the consent of the person before the legality of the processing.

**Right of appeal**

A person in the register has the right to file a complaint about the processing of personal data to the supervisory authority.
